Millbrook's Approach to Bullying

We monitor behaviour very closely and record incidents so we can quickly identify any patterns of poor behaviour or behaviour which we would deem bullying. We define bullying in our anti bullying policy as: *Bullying is behaviour by an individual or group, usually repeated over time, that intentionally hurts another individual or group either physically or emotionally.* In other words, bullying at Millbrook is considered to be, "unacceptable behaviour which occurs 'lots of times, on purpose'." Bullying can be short term or continuous over long periods of time.

At times parents report concerns to school which we quickly deal with. Sometimes parents label other children as bullies when our investigation shows that a game has gone wrong or a child has been overzealous. We never shy away from saying something is bullying if our findings show this.
