What is considered Direct Contact?

Close/direct contact is considered to be:

- Being coughed on, or
- Having a face-to-face conversation within 1 metre, or
- Having unprotected skin to skin physical contact, or
- Travel in a small vehicle with the case, or
- Any contact within 1 metre for 1 minutes or longer without face to face contact
- Extended close contact (between 1 and 2 metres for more than 15 minutes) with a case

Try to remember these principles when you are out in the community and within our school grounds.
