## What is the Sports Premium?

### ***PE and Sports Grant***

The government is providing additional funding of £150 million per annum for academic years to improve provision of physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools. This funding - provided jointly by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport - has been allocated to primary school head teachers.

This funding is ring-fenced and therefore can only be spent on provision of PE and sport in schools.

### ***Purpose of funding***

Schools must spend the additional funding on improving their provision of PE and sport, but schools have been given the freedom to choose how they do this. A list of possible uses has:

Possible uses for the funding include:

- hiring specialist PE teachers or qualified sports coaches to work alongside primary teachers when teaching PE
- new or additional Change4Life sport club
- paying for professional development opportunities in PE/sport
- providing cover to release primary teachers for professional development in PE/sport
- running sport competitions, or increasing participation in the school games
- buying quality assured professional development modules or materials for PE/sport
- providing places for pupils on after school sport clubs and holiday clubs

**Millbrook Priorities:**

**Priority 1- To ensure all children have access to high quality PE teaching and resources.**

**Priority 2- To identify and implement an assessment process which assesses pupils progress in PE.**

**Priority 3- Raise the profile of PE across the school.**

**Priority 4 - To increase our range of extra-curricular sporting activities and encourage increased participation in competitive sporting activities for all pupils.**

**Priority 5 - To further develop the schools healthy active lifestyle initiatives.**

At Millbrook we offer a large variety of sports and extracurricular activities. We aim to continue offering all of our children the opportunities to take part in a range of sports at inter, intra and county level. These include:
