

Since coming back to school in September, we have been able to provide tutoring for 64 pupils and have plans for 40 more during this term. Tutoring is one way of supporting pupils recover learning and ensure that all gaps are narrowed. Tutoring is one hour per week and lasts for 15 hours (this is directed by the Department of Education). Attendance at every session is vital and we are pleased to see pupils making excellent progress, especially those who have been attending every week. We are keen to access every opportunity to support our pupils and have already taken advantage of government funding.

Coronavirus Update

Just to keep all parent informed about progress since the start of term. Up until 13th January, sixteen pupils had contracted COVID-19 with only two pupils present in school whilst infectious. This is down to parent's great support in ensuring their child takes a lateral flow test when symptomatic or a close contact of someone with COVID. We are emailing work out to those affected and food parcels for those entitled.

As Knowsley's rates are the second highest in the country currently, we are not holding any face-to-face meetings so all parents' requests for meetings will be online via teams or zoom or over the telephone. If we need to see a parent urgently (i.e., safeguarding) then we request a lateral flow test is taken and a face mask is worn at all times. At present we have been able to manage staff absence and are doing our utmost to protect staff to ensure this.
