"Gaia" is a six-metre-wide replica of the earth based on imagery and data from NASA. Suspended in the air and slowly revolving, the artwork, gives people a chance to see our planet floating in three dimensions. A specially made surround sound composition by BAFTA and Ivor Novello Award winning composer Dan Jones will be played alongside the artworks.
