What is the Sports Premium?

PE and Sports Grant

The government is providing additional funding of £150 million per annum for academic years to improve provision of physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools. This funding - provided jointly by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport – has been allocated to primary school head teachers.

This funding is ring-fenced and therefore can only be spent on provision of PE and sport in schools.

Purpose of funding

Schools must spend the additional funding on improving their provision of PE and sport, but schools have been given the freedom to choose how they do this. A list of possible uses has:

Possible uses for the funding include:

- hiring specialist PE teachers or qualified sports coaches to work alongside primary teachers when teaching PE
- new or additional Change4Life sport club
- paying for professional development opportunities in PE/sport
- providing cover to release primary teachers for professional development in PE/sport
- running sport competitions, or increasing participation in the school games
- buying quality assured professional development modules or materials for PE/sport
- providing places for pupils on after school sport clubs and holiday clubs

Millbrook Priorities:

- P1 -The engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity guidelines recommend that primary school pupils undertake at least 30 minutes of physical activity a day in school.
- P2 The profile of PE and sport is raised across the school as a tool for whole-school improvement.
- P3 -Increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport.
- P4 Broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered all pupils.
- P5 -Increased participation in competitive sport.

At Millbrook we offer a large variety of sports and extracurricular activities. We aim to continue offering all of our children the opportunities to take part in a range of sports at inter, intra and county level. These include:
