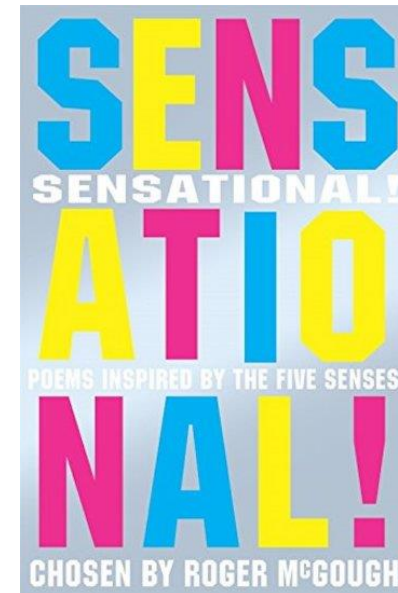
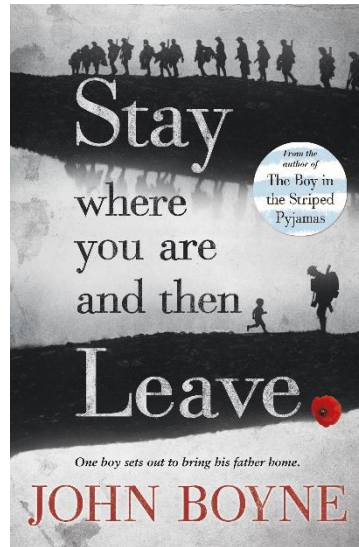

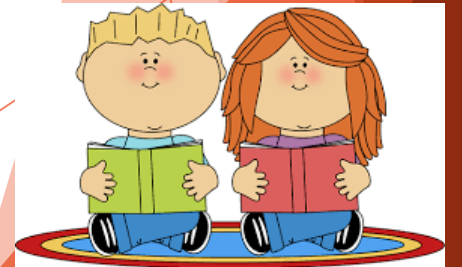

## Reading

- Children need to read EVERY night
- Expectation that children read for at least 10 minutes.
- They need to note down pages read.
- Parents to initial to show child has read - in planners.
- Chapter books try to read 1 chapter per night.
- Reading books and planners must be brought to school every day.





## Homework

- Given out each Friday
- Returned the following Wednesday
- Pages to be completed either written in Planner or on sheet itself.
- Homework should be completed in pencil – equipment was given out in school bag.
- Consequence of late homework – Yellow card
- 3<sup>rd</sup> late/incomplete homework
- 4th lunchtime
- 5th After school



## How Can You Help?

- Ensure that children are reading on a daily basis.
- Ensure homework is completed on time.
