### Dear Parents,

I hope all parents have received all the information needed about industrial action which has been planned by one of the teacher unions on a national level. As Headteacher, I have had to follow all Local Authority and DFE guidance as well as take advice from my own professional association. Headteachers have been instructed to 'take all reasonable steps to keep schools open for as many pupils as possible.' With this in mind, I have looked at classes not affected by the strike and legally should attend school. I have also ensured that staff who are in school are not covering duties and tasks of striking staff. That is a clear message from all guidance, hence the disruption for some classes. Please note that there are two teacher unions, and one did not secure enough votes to legally take industrial action therefore they must come to work.

I will ensure that parents are kept informed and reminded of any class closure days. The letter had a table on the reverse to help navigate parents through these dates. I would urge you all to store the dates on your calendar if affected at all.
