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Attendance

Last week's overall attendance was 94.2%. This is just 1.8% short of our 96% target which is the national expectation for schools. Sycamore was the highest class with 98.4% and both Elm and Pine achieved over 97% so well done to both classes. Please note that all children should be on the playground for 8:50am so they can go in as soon as the doors open. Too many children are arriving at the gate after this time which means some miss the door and are registered late.

I have been very pleased with first half of the year at Millbrook in terms of standards, behaviour, and uniform.
