Attendance

Congratulations, it was lovely to see two Year 6 pupils come out of the draw over the past two weeks.

Dear Parents,

At last Year 6 have finished their tests. They have worked extremely hard and are today helping out with the cake sale. Thank you to everyone for your generosity.

During June both Year 1 and Year 4 have to complete statutory tests called - Y1 phonics check and Y4 Multiplication check. The government collects results, and the tests must be administered between Monday 10th June and Friday 14th June. Attendance of all Y1 and Y4 is essential before and during this week as they prepare.

Year 3, 4 and 5 complete NFER from Monday 17th June. This helps inform us about their progress and what they need to do next. In Year 5 it gives us an indication on what they might achieve in Year 6 tests which again helps teachers plan to maximise pupil progress. Good attendance is vital if children are to do well and if we are to get an accurate assessment. We have been pleased with attendance so far this term and hope it continues after half term.

Please note in the school dates that children do not return to school until Wednesday 5th June, so they benefit from two extra days which are training days for staff. We hope the week brings good weather.
